Organization Builds on 20 Years of Turning Paychecks into Purpose *Transformation Network Turns 20*

- 2019 marks 20th year commitment to faith-based mission
- Transformation Network expands to 3 Ohio offices
- Announces Anniversary Theme: “Providing Jobs, Transforming Lives”

ASHLAND, Ohio, April 2, 2019 – Transformation Network, with offices in Ohio and Indiana, marks 20 years of being a steady community force providing staffing, training, and consulting services to developing people with imperfect work histories and businesses looking to build their workforce capacity.

The Ashland headquarters and training offices on Claremont Avenue opened December 2009 and the Mansfield offices opened March 2018 where Kelly Smith is office manager over both. The Clarksville Indiana office opened November 2016 after 3 years in Jeffersonville. Amanda Alexander is office manager for Clarksville.

NEW OFFICE: Clyde Ohio office opened January of this year with official ribbon cutting ceremonies held last month at their new Sandusky county service office in Clyde where David Deemer is office manager.

Commenting on the organization’s locations Dan Phillip, President and Founder said, “We’ve expanded into different communities more by invitation than plan; it has always been a new business partner’s needs that provided us with an entry into a new location.”

He went on to say, “We’ve learned a lot over 20 years that reinforces our mission: *To inspire individuals to fulfill their purpose as God’s Masterpiece*, and proves that there’s more to finding and filling jobs. Together everyone wants to work and be appreciated while contributing to building something. That’s what we facilitate.”

“Transformation Network began as an outreach ministry of Park Street Brethren Church (Ashland) to help women on welfare to improve their prospects of leaving government relief, gain confidence, and skills training to turn their lives into something better than their present circumstances,” according to Phillip.

“Today we’re a multi-million dollar entity directly impacting economic growth, staffing companies, and helping people from all walks of life become productive and proud community members. Sometimes that seems impossible, and yet we know from scripture and reality, that with God all things are possible,” said Phillip.
